

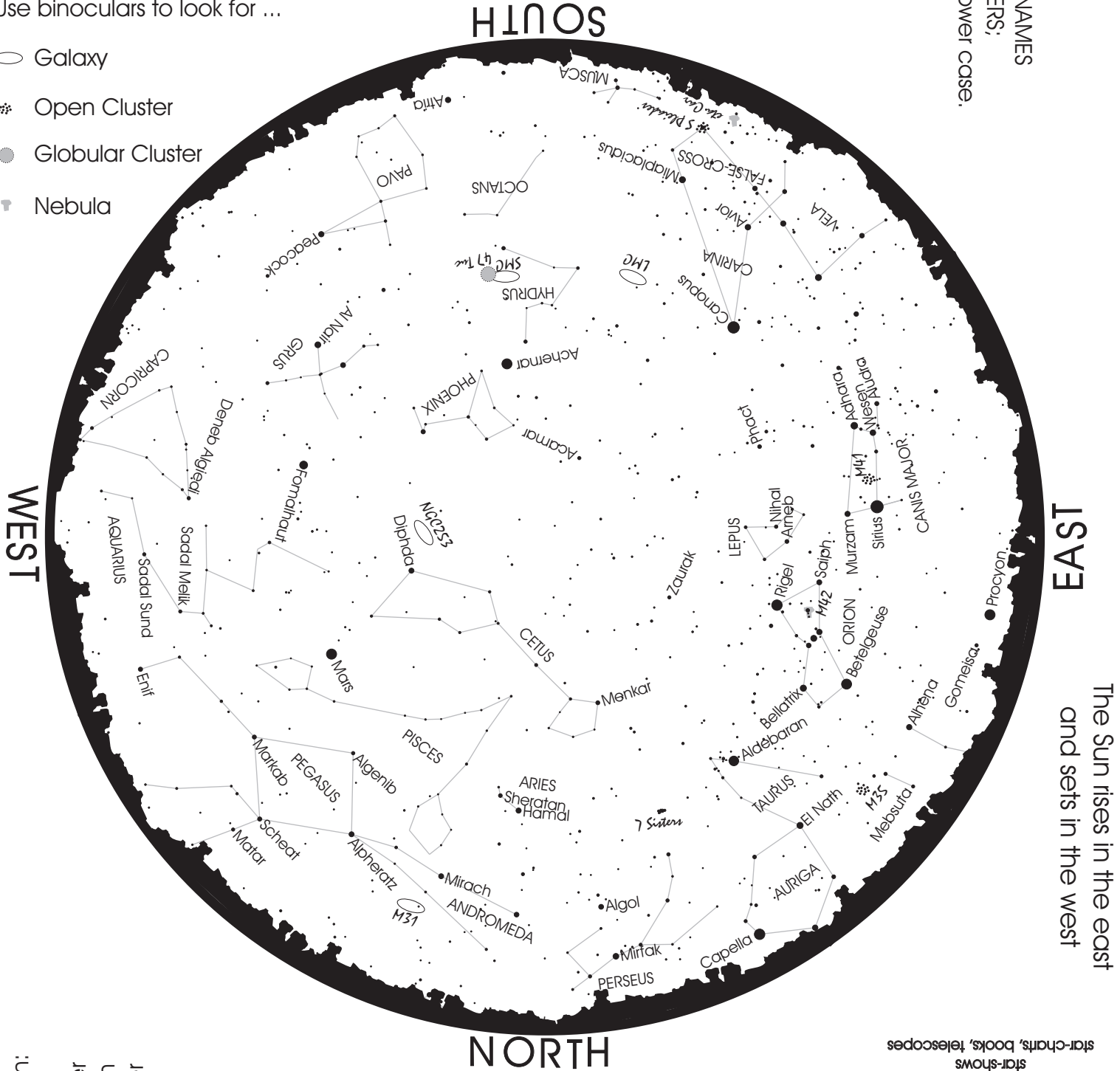
THE SOUTH AFRICAN EARLY EVENING SKY LATE DEC 2018 / EARLY JAN 2019

To find e.g. stars in the east,
face east and turn the map
so that **EAST** is at the bottom.

CONSTELLATION NAMES
ARE CAPITAL LETTERS;
star names are lower case.

Use binoculars to look for ...

- Globular Cluster
- ▴ Nebula
