star names are lower case.

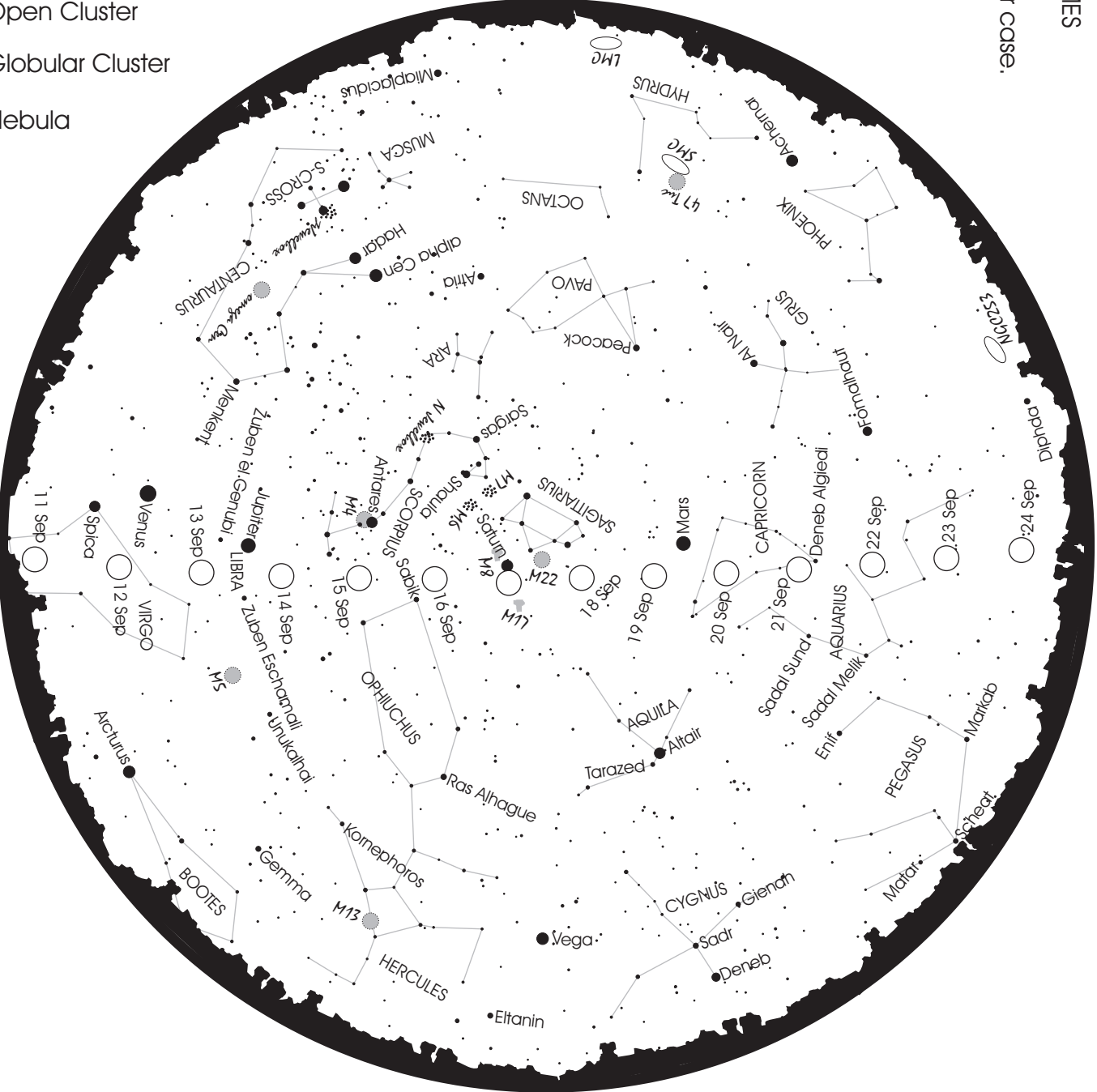
