

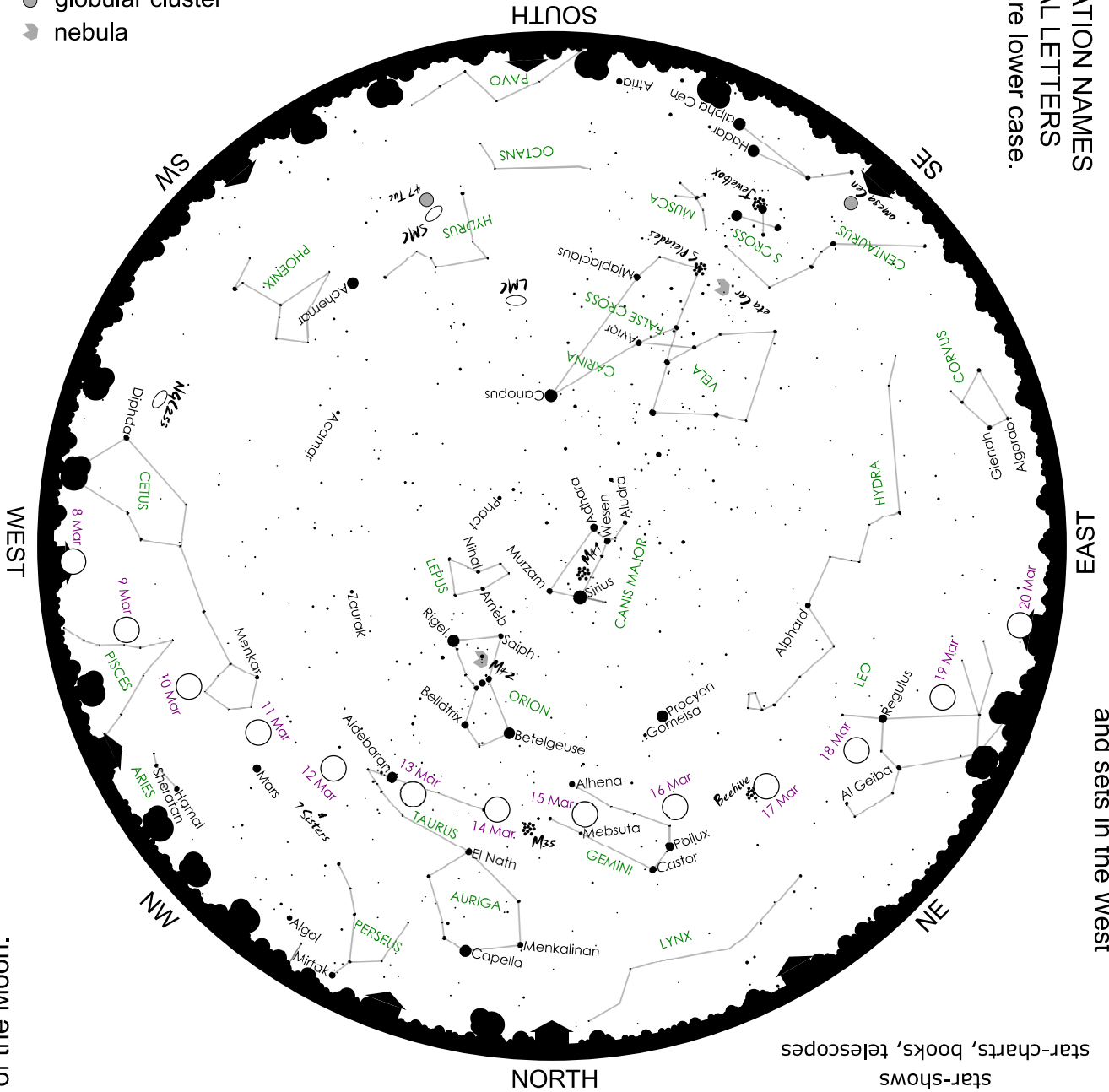
# THE SOUTH AFRICAN EARLY-EVENING SKY MID MAR 2019

To find e.g. stars in the east,  
face east and turn the map  
to put **EAST** at the bottom.

Use binoculars to look for:

- galaxy
- ✳ open cluster
- globular cluster
- ☄ nebula

CONSTELLATION NAMES  
ARE CAPITAL LETTERS  
star names are lower case.



The Sun rises in the East  
and sets in the West

Circles show the position of the Moon.

The Moon this month:

- Mar 6: new moon
- Mar 14: first quarter
- Mar 21: full moon
- Mar 28: last quarter
