

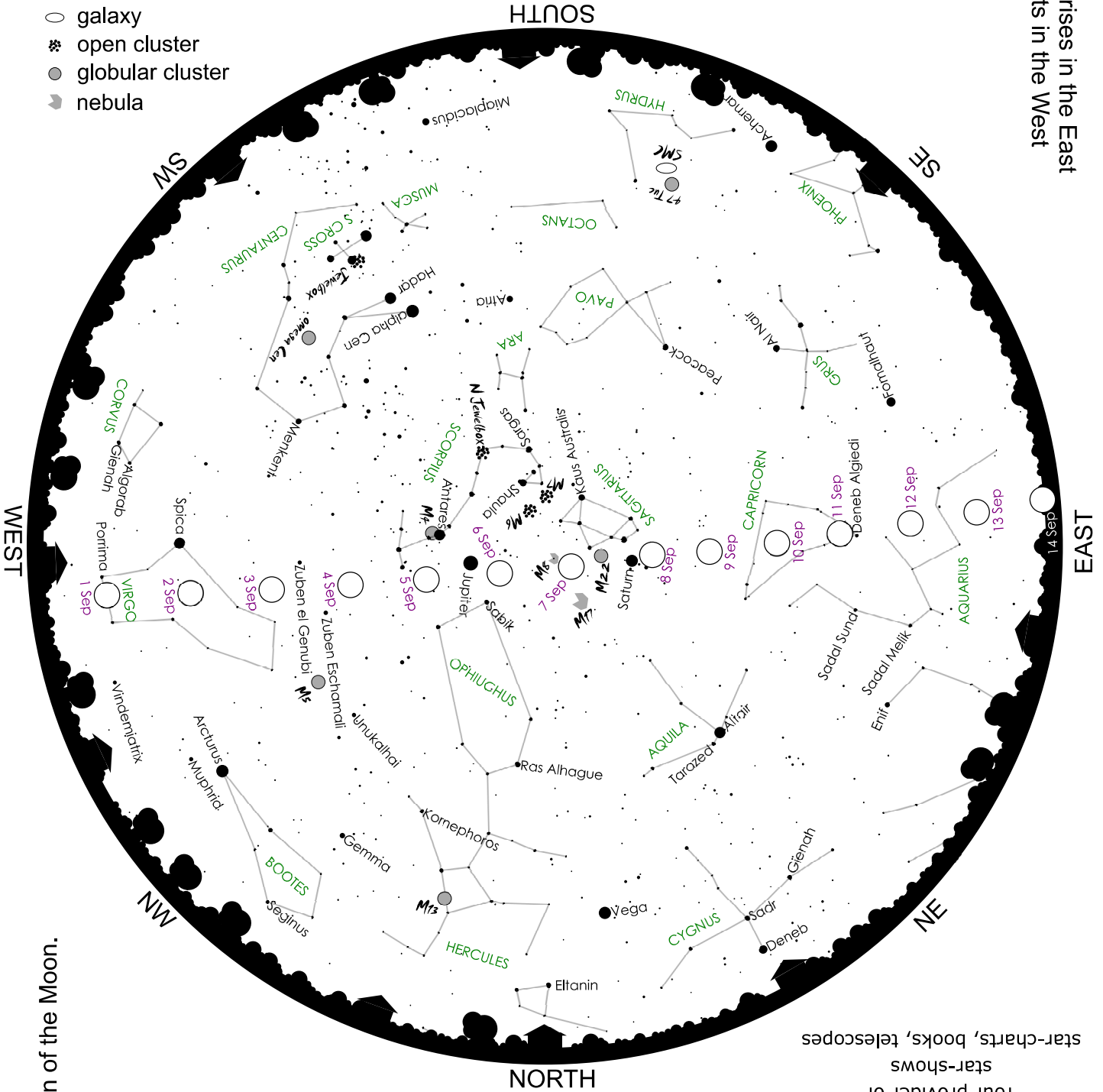
THE SOUTH AFRICAN EARLY-EVENING SKY EARLY SEP 2019

To find e.g. stars in the east,
face east and turn the map to
put **EAST** at the bottom.

The Sun rises in the East
and sets in the West

Use binoculars to look for:

- galaxy
- ✳ open cluster
- globular cluster
- ☄ nebula



Circles show the position of the Moon.

The Moon this month:

- Aug 30: new moon
- Sep 6: first quarter
- Sep 14: full moon
- Sep 22: last quarter
